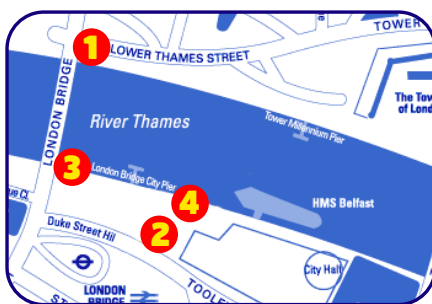

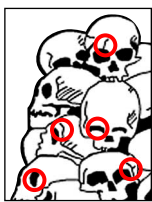
Below are the answers to our Fun Day sheets, introducing you to just a few of the family-friendly attractions in the Pool of London

2 Where am I?

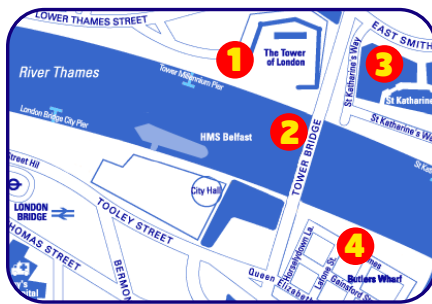
The London Dungeon

On the spot! Any of these... and more!: baby, bag, balcony, ball, balloon, barge, Belfast (HMS), bird, boat, book, bottle, bridge, buoy, busker...

On the spot! The close-ups are of the sculpture The Navigators.

1 Where am I? The Tower of London
On the spot! The Beefeater is the last picture. Its name is Traitors Gate.

2 Where am I?

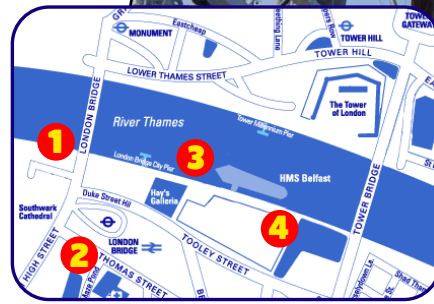
Tower Bridge

On the spot! Ravensbourne II

HMS Belfast
On the spot! There are four towers.
1 Thames, **2** Oliver, **3** Whittington, **4** Elizabeth, **5** Ravens. The first letters spell TOWER.
